The aim of the Belize High School of Agriculture Board of Management is to ensure that all BHSA students have access to improved learning. To this end, BHSA has embarked on an extensive program to upgrade and increase the number of computers in the school.

Cyber-Safety

BHSA is committed to creating and fostering a cyber-safe learning environment. Please read below some Policies and Strategies to help keep students cyber-safe when using ICT in school.

Kindly note that if a student enrolled at BHSA behaves online in a manner that threatens the wellbeing of another student or adult, on or off campus, the Principal has the authority under the School Handbook of Policies to suspend or exclude a student from school attendance or attending school.

Acceptable Use

Parents, guardians and students understand that this ICT Use Agreement covers the care, use and management of computers in a safe learning environment. Included in the management are security, email, internet access and virus protection.

Care of Computers

Students have access to computers with the understanding that the computers are in good condition. At the time of use, students are expected to report damage issues to their respective teachers.

Policies & Strategies to help keep BHSA students cyber-safe

- 1. I will not use the school's ICT equipment until my parents/guardians and myself have signed an ICT Agreement form and this form has been returned to school.
- 2. I will use the internet, email, mobile phones or any ICT equipment only for positive purposes, not to be mean, offensive or to bully or harm anyone else, even if it is meant as a joke.
